

Course Descriptions

Bible

Students must take one full credit of Bible for each year in attendance at CSCA.

1110/1111 - Understanding My Faith/The Life of Christ 1 Credit (Required) Grade 9
"You are to give him the name Jesus, because He will save His people from their sins" (Matthew 1:21). This course is a journey through the *Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John*. The student will be introduced to the person, life and ministry of Jesus Christ in order to foster a personal relationship with Him. Their faith will strengthen as they study Jesus' birth, baptism, temptations, teachings, parables, miracles, death and resurrection.

1120 - History of the Reformation Honors 1 Credit Grade 9
"The righteous shall live by faith" (Romans 1:17). This course will introduce the student to the epic events of the Reformation. History of the Reformation is a journey in time that will analyze and apply the lives and events of Martin Luther, Ulrich Zwingli, John Calvin, the English Reformation, the Puritans, Missionary Leaders and Heirs of the Reformation today. This course examines the Bible as it is worked out in the events of history to equip the Christian young person to live out their faith today. *"These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warnings for us, on whom the end of the ages has come"*. This course meets the annual Bible requirement.

Prerequisites: 3.5 GPA in Bible and History or Teacher/Guidance Approval

1130/1131 - History of My Faith/Old Testament Studies 1 Credit (Required) Grade 10
"Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith" (Hebrews 12:1-2). This course is a journey through the entire Old Testament focusing on the Historical, Wisdom, and Prophetic writings of God's people. This class will examine God's calling of Israel as the Messianic community being a light to the nations and preparing the way for Jesus Christ. *History of My Faith* is a course that will increase your Bible knowledge, increase your faith, and inspire you to live out your faith in light of those of whom, *"the world was not worthy"* (Hebrews 11:38).

Prerequisites: 9th Grade Bible or Teacher/Guidance approval for Transfers

1135/1136 - History of My Faith/Old Test. Studies Honors 1 Credit Grade 10
"Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith" (Hebrews 12:1-2). This course is a journey through the entire Old Testament focusing on the Historical, Wisdom, and Prophetic writings of God's people. This class will examine God's calling of Israel as the Messianic community being a light to the nations and preparing the way for Jesus Christ. In addition to an overview of the Old testament books and themes, students will investigate select topics that have their roots in the Old Testament which are the subject of discussion or debate in modern times. The Christian worldview regarding these topics will be presented and properly defended through alternate assessments.

Prerequisites: 9th Grade Bible or Guidance approval for transfer students, "B" in History of the Reformation or "A" in Understanding My Faith, teacher recommendation.
