Additional Information

- All tuition is paid through FACTS Tuition Payment program
- Tuition payments are due by the first of the month
- The first payment on all plans is due on June 1, 2017 and is extended over 12 months
- All tuition is Non-Refundable – see Parent / Student Handbook for additional details

Seniors:

- All tuition and fees must be paid in full by April 1, 2018 to graduate
- Monthly payment plans will be 11 months, June 1, 2017 – April 1, 2018
- Graduation Fee - \$350.00 is due by June 1, 2017, fee assists in covering graduating expenses

Scholarships / Discounts Offered:

Annual Plan	5% tuition discount on tuition will be given if tuition is paid in full on or before June 1, 2017.
Semi-Annual	3% tuition discount given with two equal payments made on or before June 1 and October 1, 2017.
Multi-Child	Siblings receive a 10% discount. Multi-child discount for a Preschool student is 5% for that child.
Pastoral	A scholarship is available if the custodial parent or guardian, bearing the financial responsibility of the student's tuition has financial hardship. The custodial parent or guardian must be ordained by the governing body of their church and be serving as a <u>full-time minister of the Gospel</u> .

McKay and Florida Step Up For Students Awards:

McKay and Florida Step Up For Students programs are paid by the State of Florida quarterly. It is your responsibility to come in and sign the checks when they are available. Checks that are not promptly signed will be subject to a \$30.00 late fee. Award recipients must pay their portion of tuition based on one of the above payment plans.

Late Fees:

Late fees (\$30.00 per month) will be assessed on any account that has outstanding balance due after 30 days. Tuition Payment plans are late the day after the date of your automatic payment, in the event your payment does not clear your bank.

NSF Fees:

Non-Sufficient Funds fees (\$30.00 per incident) will be assessed on any account that has a payment returned by your bank uncollected. It is your responsibility to make sure funds are available in your account at the time payment is made.

Extended Care Fees:

Extended Care requires a \$60 registration fee (for one child), \$75 (two children), \$90 (three children). Extended Care fees will be debited with your FACTS Tuition Payment the following month.

Delinquent Accounts:

- All tuition and fees must be current to re-enroll, receive report cards and records, and to maintain RenWeb privileges.
- **Parents of past due accounts over 60 days will be asked to keep their children home until the account is brought current or arrangements are made with the Finance Office.**
